



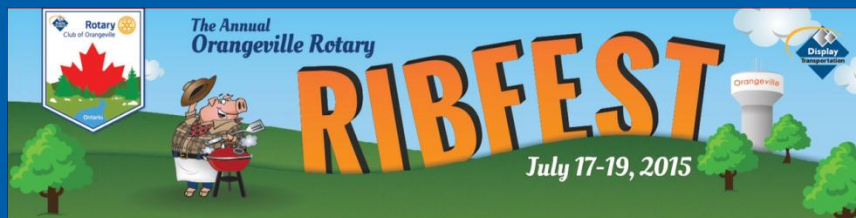
Business Meeting Highlights

Treasurer Ingrid reported in detail all of our financial activities and we continue to be solvent, thanks Ingrid!

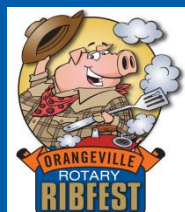
Ribfest Trailer Graphic

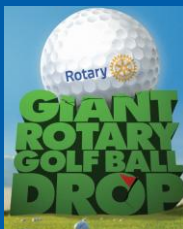


Craft Beer Fest Update

Canadian Artist, Order of Canada

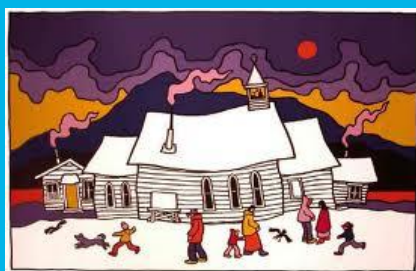
Born August 28, 1926 in Wingate, Durham, England
