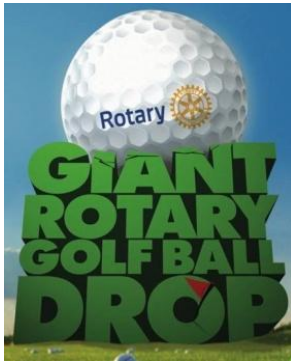

members in the immediate vicinity of Burlington.*

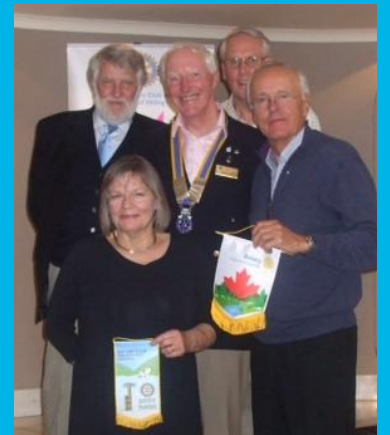
