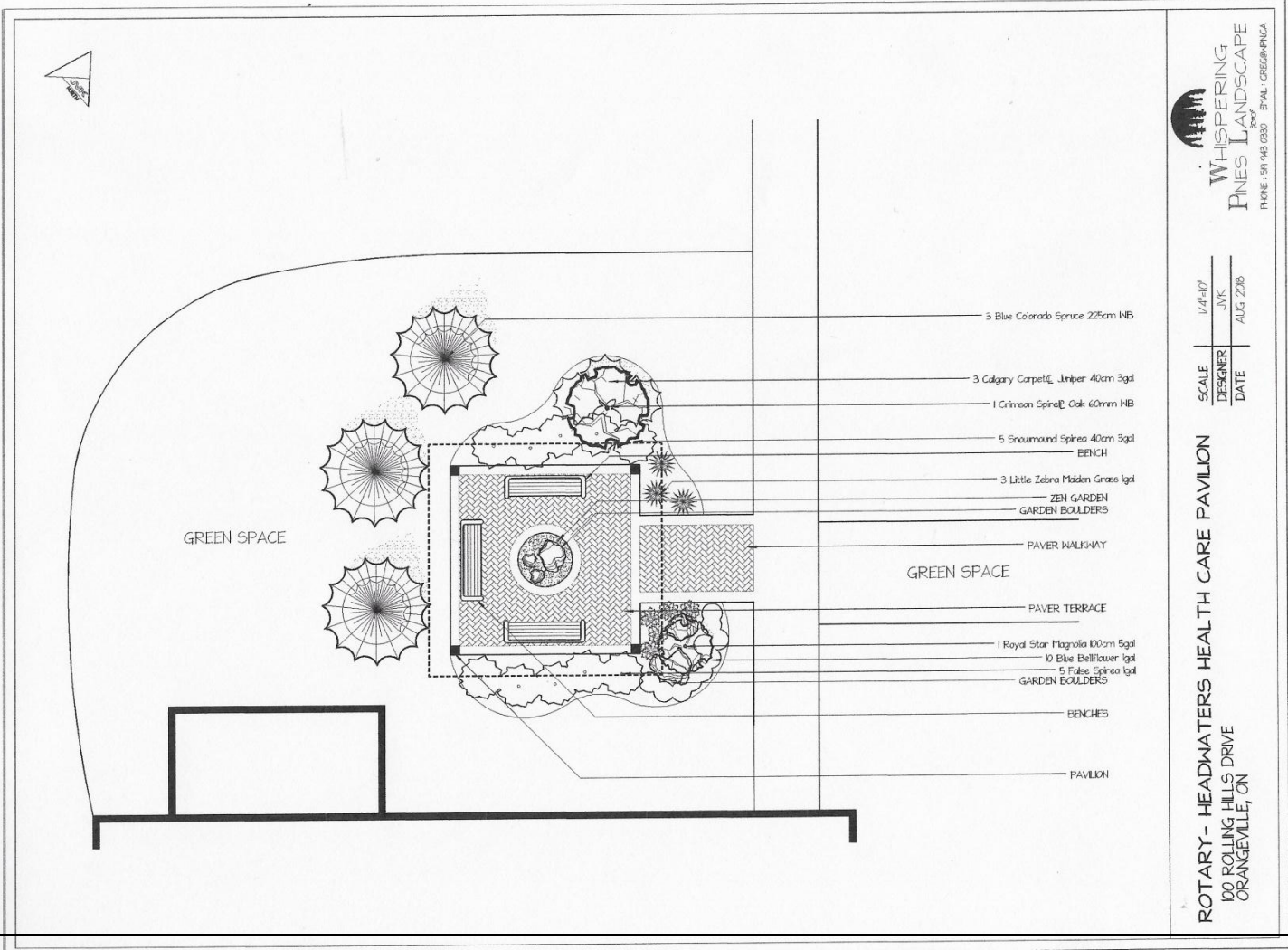
Progress on Our Hospital Pavilion Project!

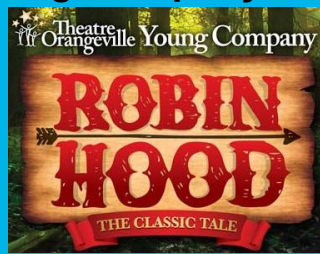
