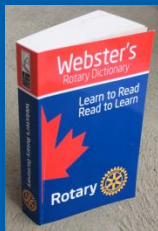

The dictionaries are being delivered this month and we hear many great stories of how well the students receive them - this is truly a most gratifying project that RCO does each year!

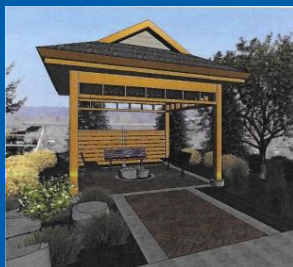


Hospital Pavilion Update: Construction is Nearing Completion!
