Robert spoke to us tonight about the many services provided by CLD in our community. Their Mission is to

"enable people with an intellectual disability to achieve their fullest potential".

Services are provided to 84 people in the Day Program, 40 in assisted living settings and 55 in residences, of which there are 13 group homes in Orangeville, Mono and East Garafraxa (& hopefully soon in Shelburne).



A new initiative is the **B Social** snack bars at the Court house, Alder St Arena, Tony Rose Arena and Georgian College.

These snack bars provide employment for some 19 people

The **Click Connect Photography** group goes on trips around town each week to take photos as they learn to express themselves.

Some of their photos have been made into Christmas Cards - 10 cards for \$30 - they're beautiful.



CPOS - Creative Players On Stage, in partnership with Theatre Orangeville, offers educational and performance opportunities for adults who have a developmental disability.

Their on-stage productions at the Opera House twice each year are wonderful - be sure to attend one, you'll keep coming back to each new show!

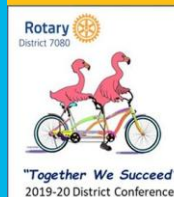


