Joint with Devonleigh Homes & Whispering Pines, welcomed by the Hospital Gardening Group.



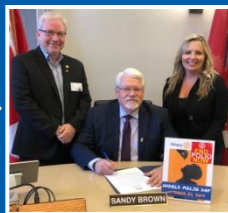
#### Family Transition Place Furniture:

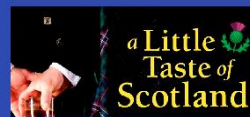
