

### Jail-N-Bail - More Background

Nancy Frater has further clarified some of the details - she was the President of the Cancer Unit at the time. Jail-N-Bail was a protected fundraiser for the Canadian Cancer Society.

It was Lynn Lowe, a volunteer with the Cancer Unit (not Heart & Stroke) who went to various Service Clubs to get support and it was RCO that came through - and "did a marvellous job".

With some help from Shelburne Rotary, and planning meetings at R.J.Burnside, the original \$25,000 goal was beaten - \$40,000.

Interesting anecdote - Cancer Unit President Nancy was among those arrested - for impersonating Marjorie Grime (an RCOH member). Nancy advises they looked a bit alike in those days and folks would often mistake them for each other.

Later RCO did **Cops for Cancer** and again RCO helped out. There may be a future story here too, we're looking for photos.
