A good Zoom meeting last evening and it was good to see a few RCO members on line to hear District Governor Rudy's Message.

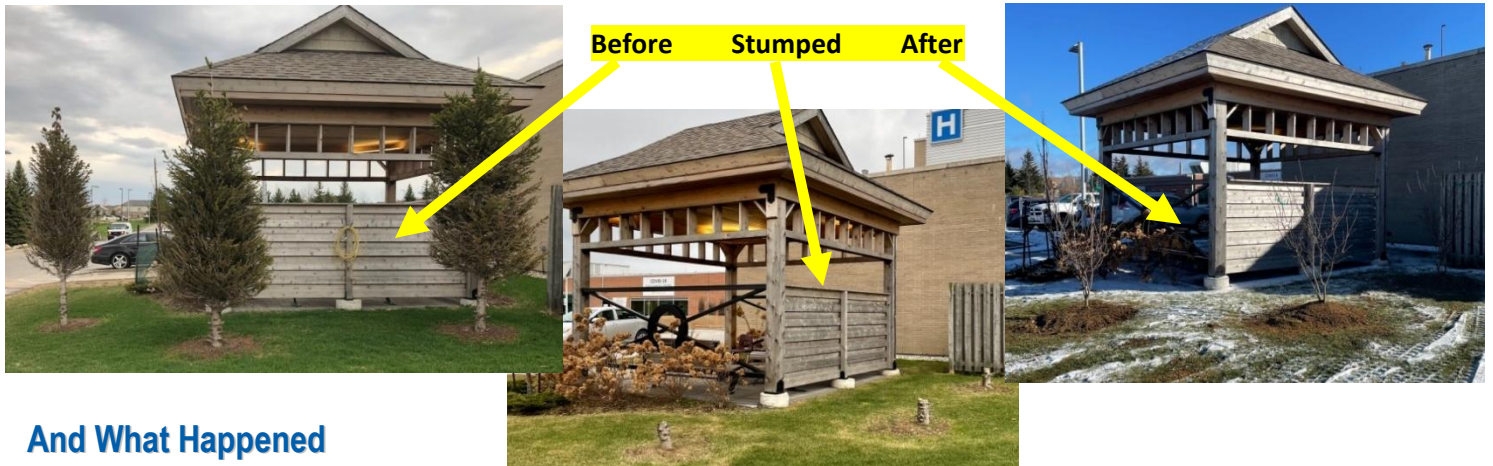
We also heard what other Clubs in our Cluster have been up to during the first half of this Rotary year. Lots of great ideas showing lots of imagination for events and social.
