A shortened version of the GrandPals program will be **starting on January 11**, one day per week (Tuesday 1-2pm) for six weeks online (Jan. 11 - Feb. 15) and we are looking for adults, **not necessarily just seniors**, who might be interested in participating.

The Rotary Club of Orangeville has contributed generously to the GrandPals program and this is an opportunity to give in other ways.

The program will be taking place for the first time online with Grade six students and will focus on five Themes. Home, Family, Learning, Work, Travel/Adventure.

There is a series of 5 questions already prepared for each theme which will assist in the discussion with the students each week.

Week one will be an orientation session to get comfortable with the online platform, followed by five sessions covering each of the Themes.

This Grade 6 Class has 28 students; 5 adults are already on board; 9 would be perfect, so 4 Rotarians would be ideal!
