
Ribfest 2022 Back to Live and In-Person! *(fingers crossed!)*

News from Haiti:

Bonnie, our contact with Friends of Ile-a-Vache, provides the following news:

"Bruce, another member of Friends of Ile-a-Vache, announced after Christmas that he was keen to sail to Haiti to oversee the projects. Take some supplies with him.

He has some solar panels to take with him as well as there are some already down there. His plan is to get the fish ponds with better aeration to help the fish grow faster and fatter.

I have found a organization in Haiti that is called KORE, I spoke to them about our issues with chickens and disease. They have been successfully setting up chicken farms throughout Haiti for yrs now.

They understand our issues and have some answers for us.... They use a particular type of bird and they give support to the farmer till they have the farm running without issue. We have been able to set up a visit with them possibly before Bruce arrives and then when he is there also.

The guy who is coming also is a fish farm expert and will advise on that as well as other aspects of Petite Eden.

Our goal is to have our projects work to their fullest potential and it will certainly help with having boots on the ground from Bruce and expert help locally. Right now there could be better outcomes on all fronts and we really want to see these projects flourish as they were planned to do. With some guidance I think this is the next step to more success.

KORE seems keen to get in there and help, often they do not have the coups all ready and functioning, so this in their eyes is a bonus.

Estel is Haitian, and Christian speaks French and Creole also so communication will be easy.

Haiti has had some Covid but seems mostly Omicron at this point. Bad coughs, fever, long lasting fatigue. One of our students had a tough time as she has asthma.

Well that is all the news for now.
