Today's Speaker: Kyle Seeback, MP Dufferin-Caledon

Thanks to PP Doug for this article (in the absence of your Editor tonight):

Kyle is dedicated to serving his community - ours! - and being a strong, committed voice for his constituents in the 44th Parliament.

Kyle represented the federal riding of Brampton West from 2011 to 2015, dedicating himself to strengthening democratic institutions and protecting freedom of speech on behalf of all Canadians,. He was instrumental in ensuring the passage of the Reform Act, a critical piece of legislation that enhances the independence of Members of Parliament and better ensuring strong, local representation in Ottawa.

ON Parliament Hill, Kyle was named Shadow Minister for Environment and Climate Change, as part of the Conservative Shadow Cabinet for the first session of the 44th Parliament. Previously he served as Vice-Chair of the Standing Committee on Citizenship and Immigration. He also served as Deputy Shadow Minister for Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship, as part of the Conservative Shadow Cabinet for the first session of the 43rd Parliament under Andrew Scheer.

Kyle is committed to achieving an inclusive, divers, and welcoming community for everyone, being a proud founding member of the 2021 Dufferin-Caledon Multicultural Award Committee.

Items highlighted by Kyle in his presentation include:

- "The Federal Government is facing a deadline of March 31st to update their Environmental Plan which they must do every 5 years."
- Current estimates are that 14 million people have been displaced in Ukraine, about the same as the Province of Ontario!"
- If Energy East had been approved with an LNG terminal, we could be helping our allies now with energy."
- The Conservatives are introducing a bill to remove the carbon tax from farm fuel. When that tax was initially introduced the average farm paid \$14,000 in that tax. The April 1st increase will take that average up to \$45,000."
