

Our Hospital was founded, by the Lord Dufferin Chapter, IODE, 00 years ago, and just celebrated 25 years in its new location. Over the years, RCO has donated a total of more than \$329,000 to the Foundation!

Some statistics - During the year, 84 babies were born, 33,286 visits were made to Emergency, 1,435,866 lab tests were given, and there were 5,600 Inpatient Admissions - truly a very busy place!

Even during Covid, the Hospital kept on innovating, launching CARE4, an integrated, seamless system of care, and a Clearer Picture Campaign with all digital radiology.

Although the Gala will not be held, the June Golf Tournament is all sold out, the smaller Sept dinner will be for 300 people, and the Tour of Headwaters Cycling event will take place in October.

An excellent presentation about our more than excellent Hospital!
